Great challenges

As the global situation impacts supplies, Home of Hope faces huge outstanding debts despite wise spending. Government-subsidised maize has been of poor quality and earlier in the year heavy rains made the road to the farm impassable and delayed their harvest, spoiling the maize. Meanwhile the number of children in their care continues to rise. Children, leadership, staff and workers at Home of Hope need our prayers.

- Give thanks to God for the generosity of donors and fundraising efforts including Zannah's marathon running which raised £850 and over £1000 was given at a Christ Church Bedford lunch. MOF has not only been able to send its usual quarterly donation, but extra for road repairs, medicines and for the transport and upkeep of HOH students in state universities.
