Matsidiso

23 years ago, Matsidiso came to Home of Hope as a baby. Supporters paid for formula milk and later food as she grew up going to Primary School. Equipment and exam fees were provided through Secondary School and she gained the results to go to study at Mwimba College of Agriculture. As part of a trustee visit she was given a laptop and phone. Monthly support paid her rent and upkeep during her studies. In April this year she graduated and, unable to find immediate employment, returned home to the only family she has known at Home of Hope, where she is sharing her up to date knowledge and expertise to help yield more from crops. This has included identifying the areas of the farm which are most suitable to grow maize and timing of planting of vegetables so these are ready for the return of students as term restarts on 14th September.



Joseph

Another student, Joseph, after graduating from Malawi University of Business and Applied Science, expresses the sense of family support that makes Home of Hope such a special place. Writing to Linda, he says, "Mama, I did it. I walked that stage as a graduate because you refused to let me walk alone. From the gates of Home of Hope to the doors of University, you have been my anchor. You weren't just part of the management but you were my mother. Your work broke barriers for me. Your love healed places I never told anyone about...You, Rev Chipeta, and the whole Home of Hope family saw an orphan and chose to believe in his future. You gave me free education, but more than that, you gave me family."

Fundraising

School Exam Results

Recent exam results are encouraging, with a 95% pass rate at the end of Primary School, which enables pupils to progress to Secondary, as well as excellent results at the end of Secondary in Form 4. For girls, the ongoing work of the dedicated staff at Protection For Education, enables them to attend classes every day of the month. As more young people benefit from the education, healthcare, and nutrition provided at the Home of Hope, more are achieving the grades needed to take this next step. We are currently supporting 44 former students through university. For students who are more practical than academic, the Vocational Training Centre helps young people learn valuable skills such as carpentry, bricklaying, tailoring, and metal fabrication. Home of Hope management is hopeful that, due to improvements in toilets, the Malawian Government will provide qualified tutors and cover their salaries from September. This is a big step forward in raising the standard of training and strengthening future opportunities for students. There is a current need for new school uniforms. £5 will buy a uniform for 1 child.
