IMPORTANT NOTES

1. You must pay an amount of income/capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the Malawi Orphan Fund reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for every £1 you give). Other taxes such as Council Tax and VAT do not count.
2. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Treasurer.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the Malawi Orphan Fund you can cancel your declaration (see note 1 above).
4. If you pay tax at the Higher Rate, you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return.
5. Under UK law, since husbands and wives are taxed separately, a separate Gift Aid Declaration must be completed by each person who wishes to give under the Gift Aid scheme, and they must be able to demonstrate that they personally have paid sufficient tax to cover the gift aid reclaim (25% of the gift).
6. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the Treasurer, or ask your local Tax Office for leaflet IR65.
